**Narrative**

On June 19, 2006 at approximately 0925, I was dispatched to a resident dispute. When I arrived on the scene, I was approached by a male, later identified as Jason Chester, who is the caller who requested our presence. He said that his mother-in-law owns the land which he rents with her permission. He said Ian McCarty had moved in June 15, 2006 and had an agreement to only have his family live in the house and a few dogs in a small pen outside the house.

The written agreement just stated that the family were to reside there and nothing else. Mr. McCarty had constructed a dog pen across from his driveway of the house and a pen behind the home had approximately 100 small dogs. Mr. Chester claimed he told Mr. McCarty not to construct the pen at that location since it was not land he was renting. The amount of dogs have created a disturbance to the neighbors. After having taking a look at the two pens and seeing lack of food and water animal control was called to the scene. While on the scene, a juvenile from the disputed residence was attempting to clean up the dog pens that were housing the dogs and giving them water from water-filled 2 liter coke bottles.

The McCartys were cited in a previous instance at their previous residence for several and just prior to our arrival the County Marshals Office took Mr. MacCarty into custody on outstanding warrants. idence on Ballground rd and

Mr. Chester was given a case card regarding this situation and given information to start the eviction process if that was what he wanted.
